#### Harvest update

We were delighted to receive this email during the half term break:

Dear all at Jessie Younghusband School,

On behalf of Chichester District Foodbank, I would like to thank you, your staff and pupils for your generous Harvest Festival donation of food to help sustain the work of Chichester District Foodbank to feed those who are in crisis.

This year we have seen a steady increase in the number of people who need our help. Feeding approximately 7015 people across the district, that's more than during the pandemic!

In addition to the emergency food parcels we supply holiday lunch packs for school children who are eligible for free school meals during term time. This Christmas we will be distributing about 1000 packs to support children over the holidays to ensure they have the option of a hot meal each day.

All of our work relies solely on donations from the community and we really value your continued support.

For your interest, the Harvest donation weighed 70.1 kg , which is the equivalent to providing 210 meals. Thank you again for your donations which are very much appreciated.
