Coronation

The Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III will take place on Saturday 6th May 2023 at Westminster Abbey in London. The ceremony will see His Majesty The King crowned alongside Her Majesty The Queen Consort.

The coronation of the new Sovereign is an occasion for pageantry and celebration, but it is also a solemn religious ceremony that has remained essentially the same over a thousand years.

To celebrate this historic event, JYS are going to be putting on several activities in school on Friday 5th May. These include:

- A large art piece with a contribution from every child that celebrates the Royal family (this will be on display at the end of the day on the playground weather dependant);
- Each child will be given the chance to decorate a cake in red, white and blue;
