This will provide you with a streamlined and simplified communication system, and we will be using it to manage many aspects of school communication over the coming weeks and months including:

- making payments
- newsletters
- attendance

You will need your unique credentials below, which were sent on a separate email on Thursday. you will need these to login, along with our school ID which is **13290**


**On your first login, please select REDEEM INVITATION CODE which can be found on the bottom of the screen** (see image).




## This week
