On Wednesday, Year 2 had a lovely morning out when they visited Dell Quay. As the sun shone, the children explored the tide line, finding crabs and many different types of shells and seaweed. Once these had been examined, the children built crab houses - arrangements of rocks and seaweed that will be covered by the incoming tide and help provide new habitats for the creatures that live on the coast.

Year 3 have been to the computer suite this week to undertake some maths testing on the computers. In an effort to see where the children are at, we will be testing the children of Key Stage 2 in Reading and Maths across the next couple of weeks. We are very grateful to the Cartmells who donated 10 sets of children's headphones last year to help us to facilitate these tests, and we are happy to accept other headphones to replace older ones as they are being worn out. We were recently awarded the trophy (on the left) for our pledge to promote and be involved in girls' football.
