WSCC Easter Clubs

Bookings for the WSCC Easter Holiday Activity & Food programme are now open for all families who are entitled to benefits related to free school meals.

Families can find booking information on the <u>Family Information Service website</u>; more providers will be added daily in the coming weeks, so please keep trying if you cannot find what they are looking for straight away.

The HAF programme is fully funded by the Department for Education and offers children, who are entitled to benefits related to free school meals, the opportunity to attend participating holiday activity clubs and have a free meal.

Benefits-related free school meals (FSM) are available to pupils if their parents are in receipt of one of the qualifying benefits and have a claim verified by West Sussex County Council. If you think may be eligible, please contact the school office who can help you complete an application or alternatively complete an <u>online application</u>.

If you are not entitled to free school meals, there are still many opportunities running in the local area during the Easter holidays. These include:


