Recently, there have been instances of parking-related concerns near the school premises. To ensure the safety and convenience of all families, we kindly request that you park considerately when dropping off or picking up your children.

Please be mindful of the following:

- 1. No Parking in Designated Areas: Avoid parking in areas marked as no parking zones near the entrance on Norwich Road.
- 2. Respect Neighbours' Driveways: Ensure that driveways of our neighbours are not blocked by parked vehicles.
- 3. Pavements: Keep pavements clear of cars to allow safe passage for children and their families.
- 4. Engine Idling: Turn off your vehicle's engine when waiting, to minimise emissions and promote a healthier environment.
