Alongside our bank of ad hoc volunteers, who are vital in helping to run school fundraising events, we are looking to create some new and exciting roles and responsibilities within the Committee this term.

Please see below a list of the current and desired roles and a small description of what each role entails. It would be wonderful to fill each role with two willing volunteers!

#### Position: Chair of the Friends Committee (Sam Game)

Description of role: Running the Committee and managing team members. The chair provides leadership for the Committee, sets the agendas for the meetings and manages the meetings and events.

#### Position: Treasurer (Jessica Rides)

Description of role: Works closely to support the Chair of the Committee. Manages the day-to-day finances, keeping a detailed record of the PTA's financials and filing the yearly accounts. Ensures all licenses and governance is kept up to date. Reimbursing Committee members expenses.

#### Position: Co-Treasurer (Emilie Williams)

Description of role: Manages the banking, ensures money is kept safely after events, arranges floats and assists the Treasurer.

## Position: Second Hand Uniform Coordinator (Sonia Morgan)

Description of role: Second hand/preloved uniform is brilliant! It is an affordable and environmentally friendly way of purchasing preloved uniform. The uniform coordinator sorts donations and runs uniform sales.





#### **Desired Roles**

**Position: Communications Officer** - This person will be involved in getting the word out for the committee! Managing the social media accounts, emails, posters and keeping the website page up to date.

This would suit someone confident with good technology and communication skills.

**Position: Bake Sale Coordinator** - The PTA bake sales are invaluable to any committee, bringing in vital funds to the school all year round. We are looking for someone to arrange several bake sales throughout the year, encouraging people to get baking and run the stalls. This would suit someone organised who has a passion for baking.

**Position: Class Rep** - We are currently looking for class reps for YR, Y3, Y4, Y6. An essential role, the class reps will be the communication channel between the Friends and the class. They are key in securing ad hoc volunteers for events and reminding parents/carers about upcoming fundraising events.

This would suit someone friendly and approachable, with good communication skills.

**Position: Raffles and Grants Officer** - This role involves reaching out to local businesses for raffle prizes and sponsorship. They will also research and apply for local grants. Working closely with the school and PTA to source new funding opportunities.
