KS2 SATs

We wanted to share with you how proud we are of all of the Year 6 pupils who sat their SATs this week. For those of you that don't know, SATs stand for Standard Assessment Tests. SATs are administered by primary schools that measure children's educational achievement in Years 2 and 6, with the ultimate aim of holding schools to account for the attainment of their pupils and the progress they make. These assessments take place in the May of year 6 (age 11) and are more formal tests in English (grammar, punctuation, spelling and reading) and maths. Each paper is 45 minutes long.

This week

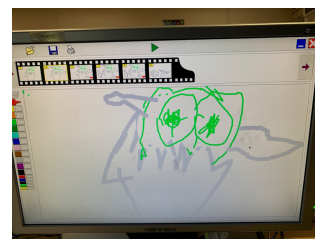
