<u>"Air Up" Water bottles</u>

We would like to address concerns that have come to our attention regarding the use of "Air Up" water bottles in school. It has been observed that many children have been bringing in air up water bottles. As you may be aware, air up water bottles use a special pod that releases flavours when air is inhaled. While this may make drinking water more enjoyable for some children, the bottles have been causing distractions and disruptions in the classroom.
